## RE: Port restrictions and temporary actions on effect of pandemic (COVID-19)

This letter provides clarification and localization regarding the previously distributed External Memorandums regarding the actions of Namport in connection with the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

In the port of Luderitz:

- 1. The External Memorandum of March 17, 2020 and the External Memorandum of March 20, 2020 strictly enforceable in the port of Luderitz.
- 2. Memorandum dated 20.03.2020 replaces clause 14 in the Memorandum dated 17.03.2020.
- 3. Any vessel calling at the port of Luderitz must be quarantined at 14 days on anchorage, the travel from the last port of call or time from latest change of the crew at sea or any contacts with anybody at sea can be added to quarantine period depending on what happened later.
- 4. Quarantine actions also include vessels that have made bunkering or transshipment at sea.
- 5. Minimize agents and customers visiting to the Port Control Office, planning to make using by telephones and e-mails at 12:00 am. Physical presence only in case of difficulties with the allocation for the vessels in next 24 hours.

## Reminder:

Pay attention to clause 9 and 13 of the External Memorandum of 03.17.2020. Additional information on clause 11 of the External Memorandum of 03.17.2020 will be announced later.
