PURPOSE OF THE JOB:

To operate Mobile Harbor Cranes and Mechanical Lifting and Stacking Equipment by moving and placing cargo from vessels to shore, and vice versa. The role reports directly to the Supervisor: General Cargo Operations.

- Perform daily checks on mechanical lifting equipment.
- Operate Mobile Harbor Cranes and equipment across all categories, CAT 2, 3, 4 & 5.
- Consistently maintain maximum levels of crane productivity by assisting in planning of the vessel-discharging and loading of containers and break bulk.
- Operate safely and efficiently, always ensuring smooth movement of the cargo for safe operation.
- Perform data capturing duties.
- Execute and assist with tandem lifting operations.
